Audiovisual recording technicians control the technical operation of equipment for recording and editing images and sounds.

Their tasks include:

- control equipment for sound recording;
- control equipment for editing and mixing images and sounds, in order to guarantee satisfactory quality and create special image and sound effects;
- apply knowledge of the principles and practices of recording and editing images and sounds to identify and solve problems.

Examples of occupations included in this primary group

- Camera operators
- Sound recording technicians
- Video editors
- Audiovisual technicians

3832 Broadcasting technicians

Broadcasting technicians control the technical operation of equipment for the transmission by radio and television of images and sounds, and other types of telecommunication signals by land, sea or aircraft.

Their tasks include:

- control systems, including by satellite, for the transmission and broadcasting of radio and television programs;
- control radio communication systems, satellite systems and multiplex systems by land, sea or aircraft;
- apply knowledge of the principles and practices of broadcasting, telecommunication terminals and transmission systems to identify and solve problems;

- carry out emergency repairs.
