8201 Mechanical machinery assemblers

Mechanical machinery assemblers assemble components or mechanical parts of machines, in accordance with strict rules and regulations.

Their tasks include:

- Assemble and install prefabricated parts or components to form sub-assemblies, mechanical machines, engines and finished motor vehicles;
- Examine work orders, specifications, diagrams, and drawings to determine required materials and assembly instructions;
- record production and exploitation data in the specified forms;
- inspect and test completed components and assemblies;
- reject faulty assemblies and components.

Examples of occupations included in this primary group

- Engine builders
- Bench mechanics (trucks)
- Vehicle assemblers
- Engine installers
- Mounters adjusters of mechanical elements of aeronautical engines
- Turbine assemblers
